

St. Martin – Holy Family Cemetery

Summary of Cemetery Regulations and Restrictions

- Funeral Flowers holders' containers, baskets and easels will be removed between the Third and fifth day following the funeral service.
- Artificial Flowers pertinent to the season and **in approved containers** are permitted at any time. ANY floral arrangements will be removed and discarded when they become discolored, wilted, seasonally inappropriate or unsightly in manner.
- Live cut flowers **in approved containers** are permitted at any time. Glass containers, tin cans, plastic containers, toy stuffed animals, solar lights, statues, ceramic ware, porcelain, shepherds' hooks, wood structures, photographs, signs, paper items (except approved photograph cameos attached to monument), cement structures and benches constructed of any non-approved materials are not permitted at any time. **All unapproved items will be disposed of on February 1st and July 1st.**
- Special Christmas arrangements and wreaths are permitted from December 1st through January 15th. All such decorations must be secured to withstand strong winds.
- Special arrangements for any other holiday may be placed three (3) days before and five (5) days following a specific holiday. Arrangement not in keeping with floral regulations will be removed after the fifth day and discarded
- Any unauthorized memorial will be removed and discarded.
- Do not remove sod (grass) from graves.
- No trenches may be dug around spaces or lots.
- Planting of trees, plants, shrubs, or flowers is not permitted at any time.
- Curbing, edging, fencing, beds, borders, bark mulch or decorative pebbles marbles or rocks is not permitted any time.
- The cemetery is not responsible for any memorial, vase picture, or memorial portrait (cameo or flowers placed on graves).
- The speed limit in the cemetery is 15 miles per hour and strictly enforced.
- NO SOLICITING on premises
- NO PETS on premises.
- NO HUNTING OR FIREARMS on premises.

The beauty and serenity of this cemetery can only be sustained through proper maintenance. Adherence to regulations better enables the attainment of that goal and helps to ensure that the safety of all who visit the cemetery.
